- Be a committed Christian and an active member of a church

Desired Criteria

- Experience as a Counsellor within a School setting would be viewed favourably
- Recommending relevant, classroom based strategies to teachers and support staff for assistance with student behavioural management, self-regulation issues, social competency skills etc.
- Make recommendations in relation to students individual learning plans when required
