Reporting to the Chief Risk Officer, this is a newly created role that will assist with the enhancement and embedding of the risk and compliance framework. This could be an excellent role for a risk and compliance candidate that shares similar values to work close to home in a broad enterprise wide role. Some of the responsibilities will include:

- Updating and maintaining risk registers at a group level as well as at a business unit level
- Ensure business units are engaged and have practices that align to the groups risk management framework and requirements
- Facilitating risk management and compliance discussions and workshops with key stakeholders in business units
- Risk and compliance reporting as required
- Assisting with adherence to policies and procedures as well as identifying and escalating breaches and incidents.
- Working closely with the CRO on other activities to embed the risk and compliance framework

The ideal candidate for this role;

- 4+ years risk management experience (exposure to risk workshops and group wide risk frameworks would be ideal)
- Some experience in compliance
- A strong relationship focus i.e. able to foster relationship with a diverse range of stakeholders
- Excellent communication skills
- Values that are aligned to the organisation
- Hands on approach and the ability to work in a lean environment
- This role will give you the breadth and depth of exposure to and enterprise wide risk and compliance function. You will be working with a Christian non-profit organisation that is strictly values and faith based.
