The Program

The Intern Program is a 12–24-month school-based training program designed to build skills in a broad range of day-to-day school experiences. Alongside your university study, and as part of the staff team in one of our 18 schools, you will be supported by a dedicated mentor to engage in immersive learning opportunities in preparation for your first teaching role.

Successful applicants will engage in collaborative learning events with other interns across Anglican Schools, work 2 days a week in one of our schools, and engage in the co-curricular life of the school - deepening their understanding of integrating their faith into their teaching practice.

Who Should Apply?

- Education students active in their Christian faith & involved in a Bible-based church.
- Commencing 3rd or 4th year of undergraduate Education in 2027 OR 1st/2nd year of M Teach in 2027.
- Completed LANTITE.
- Hold a credit average across tertiary studies.
- Current Working with Children Check (WWCC).
- Evidence of a successful professional placement.

Program Benefits & Inclusions

- Paid employment 2 days/week under Independent Schools CMEA 2025.
- Option for additional casual paid days once conditional accreditation is achieved.
- 1-1 mentoring with an experienced educator.
- Access to specialised online mentoring platform (MOSAIC).
- Term training events & membership of a collaborative professional network.
- Preferred candidate status for full-time positions in TASC schools.
